ORDINANCE NO. 2014-1225

REPEAL OF CHAPTER 68 OF THE BRENTWOOD CODE OF ORDINANCES, ALARM DEVICES

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BRENTWOOD REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY CHAPTER 68 OF THE BRENTWOOD CODE OF ORDINANCES, ALARM DEVICES, ADOPTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BRENTWOOD ON MARCH 2, 1982 AS CHAPTER XIII, PART 1, OF THE 1982 CODE OF ORDINANCES, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Section 1006(4) of the Pennsylvania Borough Code (53 P.S. § 46006(4)) imposes a duty upon Borough Council to enact, revise, repeal and amend ordinances and resolutions pursuant to Article XXXIII of the Borough Code, not inconsistent with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as it deems beneficial to the Borough.

WHEREAS, Brentwood Borough Council in 1982 enacted an Alarm Devices Ordinance, which is currently codified at Chapter 68, §§ 68-1 through 68-11, of the Brentwood Code of Ordinances.

WHEREAS, in 1998, the Pennsylvania General Assembly enacted a statute entitled "Control of Alarm Devices and Automatic Dialing Devices," which was signed into law by the Governor, and which, as amended, is codified in the Pennsylvania Crimes Code at 18 Pa. C.S. § 7511, and

WHEREAS, given the above-referenced statute pertaining to the control of alarm devices and automatic dialing devices, the Borough of Brentwood at this time deems it appropriate to repeal its Alarm Devices Ordinance in its entirety.


NOW, THEREFORE, COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BRENTWOOD ORDAINS AND ENACTS as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 68 of the Brentwood Code of Ordinances, Alarm Devices, adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Brentwood on March 2, 1982, as Chapter XIII, Part 1, of the 1982 Code of Ordinances, as amended, is hereby repealed in its entirety; however, such repeal shall not affect any act done under such prior Ordinance herein repealed.


