WHEREAS, Edward P. Battle, served in the Navy from 1943 through December 1945 as a member of the 21st ALCORN, a land-based Naval Air Station, and

WHEREAS, Edward P. Battle, saw action in the invasion of the Islands of Roi-Namur in the Marshall Islands while serving with the 4th Marine Division, and while on Roi Islands, he was one of three men who met Charles Lindberg who was called upon as a consultant for the planes; and, later was in a naval unit that occupied Japan after the surrender, and

WHEREAS, after the war, **Edward P. Battle** attended Duquesne University and earned a Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree, beginning a career as a Certified Public Accountant lasting for fifty-six years and ownership of his accounting practice, and

WHEREAS, Edward P. Battle, for many years, has volunteered his expertise and experience in accounting by dedicating his time to the Brentwood Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1810 as their accountant, and mentor, and

WHEREAS, Edward P. Battle, a family man, a former military serviceman, and semi-retired Certified Public Accountant is our beloved friend, and a valuable asset to the Brentwood Community, and
