Also Present were members of the Brentwood School District Board.

a. School District Web Site

R. Schubert congratulated the School District for its website updates.

b. School District - Update on Feasibility Study

Dr. Amy Burch gave an update on the School District's Feasibility Study.

R. Schubert suggested that perhaps the School District could piggyback onto the Borough's Road Program if they desire to potentially save costs on future paving needs.

c. Borough - DARE Program/Drug Prevention Program - R. Schubert

R. Schubert requested that this item be added to the agenda. He asked if there was any interest within the School District to continue this program.

Dr. Burch explained that PA Act 44 require schools to provide drug prevention programs. She stated that the District may be interested in working with the Borough. However, the mandatory program does not necessarily need to follow the traditional DARE model.

A. Doyle mentioned that the Public Safety Committee has met with the Allegheny County Health Department to provide some drug awareness and outreach work.

J. Frombach mentioned the requirement that each School District provide a Safety Director. School

safety has become a major national concern.

d. Borough - New Municipal Building Update

G. Zboyovsky gave an update on the project and schedule. Estimated date of completion is July 2020. He mentioned the sidewalk in front of the Snee Dairy Building will more than likely need to be closed during construction.

D. Troy added that the current borough building property is going to be marketed to developers and that the Borough will prepare an RFP.

e. Borough - Pool Project Update

G. Zboyovsky gave an update on the Borough Pool project and the tentative schedule. Stated that the pool will be closed for the 2019 season. He also mentioned that the Bath House will be demolished, which would eliminate the existing locker rooms that are used by visiting football teams. The projected opening is scheduled for Memorial Day 2020.

f. Borough - Crossing Guard Contract

G. Zboyovsky noted that Council approved first Crossing Guard Contract with rate increases of 6%, 3%, 3%, and 3% between 2018 and 2021. The effective date of the contract is July 1, 2018. A copy will be forwarded to the District once edits are made and finalized.

g. Borough - Micro Hospital Update

Mayor Troy gave an update on the Allegheny Health Network's Micro-Hospital project and how it will benefit the community. He went on to discuss the aggressive construction schedule, which is designed to see the facility open in the fall of 2019.

The property will be taxable as it is going to be leased by a private developer. The ground breaking is probably going to take place in November.
