**a. New Municipal Building Update - G. Zboyovsky**

Manager Zboyovsky gave an update on the contractor name, the total amount of the award, and the scope of work. Estimated completion date is July or August 2020. The project will necessitate a temporary sidewalk closer on Brownsville Rd from E Willock Rd to Hillman St.

**b. Brentwood Swimming Pool Renovations Update - G. Zboyovsky**

Manager Zboyovsky gave an update on the contractor name, the total amount of the award, and the scope of work. Indicated that Council accepted the Add Alternate Options to include spray features and light towers. Reviewed the alteration in the project schedule to a delay with receiving the necessary federal approval on the grant award. The project is scheduled for completion in October 2020.

**c. Park Fund Summary - G. Zboyovsky**

Manager Zboyovsky indicated that, due to the lease agreement with the school district, \$30,000 is annually deposited in the Park Fund for capital repairs. Mr. Kircher asked if this fund was restricted to replacing the stadium turf, and Manager Zboyovsky clarified that the funds can be used for all facilities that are utilized by school district teams, which includes Field #3, Field #4, and the stadium.

Mrs. Werner indicated that she was under the impression that vehicles could not be used on the stadium track. Manager Zboyovsky responded that vehicular access is highly limited to prevent unnecessary damage.

**d. School District Renovation Projects - A Burch**

Dr. Burch gave a detailed update on the School District Renovation projects.

**e. Common Sense Media Distinction Award - A. Burch**

Dr. Burch explained the nature of the award. Indicated that Brentwood is the first School District in Allegheny County to receive this distinction.

**f. Stadium ADA Parking - D. Werner**

Mrs. Werner asserted that the Borough should be making certain that handicapped parking is available during game. Stated that the police should be enforcing lot restrictions. Mr. Carnevale indicated that the Parks & Recreation Committee will be convening to discuss this matter.

**g. Public Comment**

An unidentified resident asked if the Borough will provide a crossing guard at the Brownsville Road-Marylea Ave intersection when the sidewalk is closed in front of the Borough Building site, and Manager Zboyovsky responded affirmatively.
