Attached you will find the breakdown of calls handled by Brentwood Emergency Medical Services during the Month of August 2013.

In August we responded to a total of 191 calls both emergency and non-emergency type calls.

The report breaks down the response outcome of every call we handled. During the month we transported a total 145 patients.

We had a total of 11 refusals of transport calls during the month.

In August our average response time from Dispatch to a call and then on scene in the borough of Brentwood was 5.1 minutes. Times vary on priority of dispatch call and if we are coming from a distance to cover the call. Also attached is the Priority Code Breakdown.
