Attached you will find the breakdown of calls handled by Brentwood Emergency Medical Services during the Month of February 2012.

In February we responded to a total of 203 calls both emergency and non-emergency type calls.

Our average response time to calls dispatched in the Brentwood area was 1.9 minutes to a residence upon request.

The report breaks down the response outcome of every call we handled. During the month we transported a total 151 patients.

We had a total of 5 refusal of transport calls during the month.

We had a total of 11 lift assists calls during the month. These we just do a public assist for a resident who falls and is uninjured or needs help too and from a car to their home.

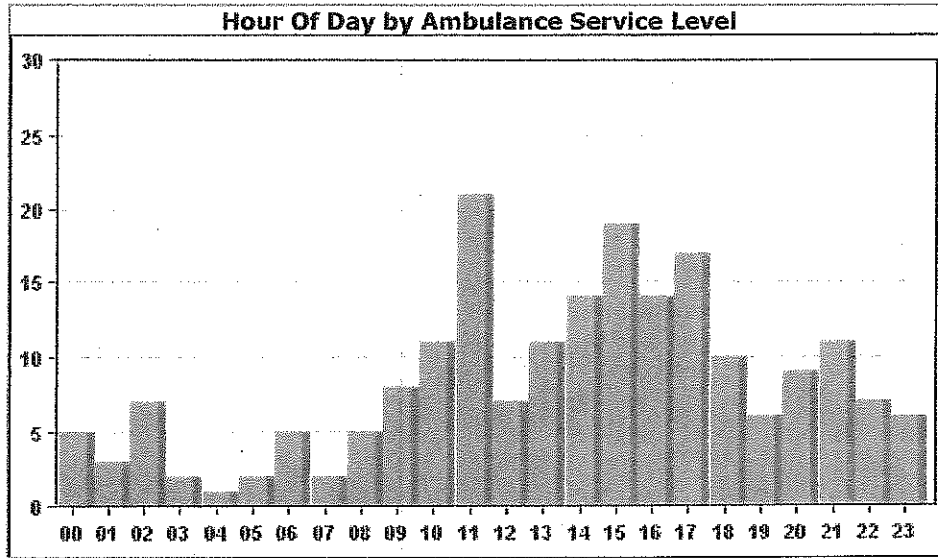
