**Ladies and Gentlemen,**

Attached you will find the breakdown of calls handled by Brentwood Emergency Medical Services during the Month of August 2012.

In August we responded to a total of 194 calls both emergency and non-emergency type calls.

Our average response time to calls dispatched in the Brentwood area was 1.7 minutes to a residence upon request.

The report breaks down the response outcome of every call we handled. During the month we transported a total 136 patients.

We had a total of 16 refusal of transport calls during the month.

In August we handled 2 calls for Mutual aid into Whitehall and the City of Pittsburgh

In August we had a total of 3 calls were handled by mutual aide services for us while we were on other calls.
