Ladies and Gentlemen,

Attached you will find the breakdown of calls handled by Brentwood Emergency Medical Services during the Month of December 2013.

In December we responded to a total of 177 calls both emergency and non-emergency type calls.

The report breaks down the response outcome of every call we handled. During the month we transported a total 141 patients.

We had a total of 7 refusals of transport calls during the month.

In December our average response time from Dispatch to a call and then on scene in the borough of Brentwood was 5.3 minutes. Times vary on priority of dispatch call and if we are coming from a distance to cover the call. Also attached is the Priority Code Breakdown.

In December we had 10 calls handled by Mutual Aid Ambulance Services due to us being on calls.
