Ladies and Gentlemen,

Attached you will find the breakdown of calls handled by Brentwood Emergency Medical Services during the Month of May 2013.

In May we responded to a total of 216 calls both emergency and non-emergency type calls.

The report breaks down the response outcome of every call we handled. During the month we transported a total 150 patients.

We had a total of 13 refusals of transport calls during the month.

In May our average response time from Dispatch to a call and then on scene in the borough of Brentwood was 4.8 minutes. Times vary on priority of dispatch call and if we are coming from a distance to cover the call. Also attached is the Priority Code Breakdown.

In May we had 21 calls handled by Mutual aide services in Brentwood while we were on calls.
