Ladies and Gentlemen,

Attached you will find the breakdown of calls handled by Brentwood Emergency Medical Services during the Month of February 2013.

In February we responded to a total of 167 calls both emergency and non-emergency type calls.

The report breaks down the response outcome of every call we handled. During the month we transported a total 126 patients.

We had a total of 7 refusals of transport calls during the month.

In February our average response time from Dispatch to a call and then on scene in the borough of Brentwood was 5.2 minutes. Times vary on priority of dispatch call.

In February we had 20 calls handled by Mutual aide services in Brentwood while we were on calls.
