

They are pursuing the possibility of installing surveillance cameras along that corridor.

5. On April 10, 2012, I was contacted by the Allegheny County District Attorney's office who offered a grant for the installation of a surveillance camera to be installed in the 2700 block of Brownsville Road. This was in response to Councilman Clyde Zimmerman making contact with the District Attorney at the recent Seven Springs conference. The total value of the grant will be in excess of \$5,000.00 and will enable police to capture crime activity taking place along that corridor on video.
6. On April 5, 2012, Councilman David Wenzel was responsible for the apprehension of an actor wanted by the Brentwood Police. Councilman Wenzel recognized the actor who was on Provost Road and was able to obtain a registration number from his vehicle that he provided to police. Through that information, the actor was located and taken into custody. He was charged with the following felonies, Theft by Deception and Home Improvement Fraud.
7. The police department received two, "Letters of Commendation", that are enclosed in my report.
