Other Police Business;

- Both new officers, Carl Rech and Farrell Wagner, are doing an excellent job so far during their probationary period.
- Approximately (8) eight officers have completed their mandatory In-Service classes required to maintain their certifications. All should be completed before March 31st.
- On January 14th, an individual committed an armed robbery at the Spartan pharmacy located on Clairton Blvd. The incident is currently under investigation.
- On January 10th, a reported home invasion took place on E. Garden Road and is currently under investigation. On January 14th, in the same area, Officer Mikelonis was conducting surveillance and made an arrest of an individual who was in possession of (50) bags of heroin.
- On January 26th, two attempted robberies took place. The first at the Dairy Queen in Whitehall Borough on RT 51 and the other at Long John Silvers on Brownsville Road in the City of Pittsburgh. Both occurred within approximately 20 minutes of each other. Approximately 15 minutes later, Officers Zeppuhar and Swick located the suspects in the Burger King parking lot located on Brownsville Road and took the actors into custody.
