Other Police Business;

- The officer who was off work due to an injury has returned to full duty
- One of the new police vehicles was struck from behind causing moderate damage while parked in front of the police department. The operator fled the scene of the accident and was apprehended at the intersection of Rte. 51 and Rte. 88. He has been charged with DUI and numerous traffic offenses.
- Approximately five vehicles were entered during the night on Sceneridge Avenue and items such as tools and electronics were stolen from inside. Most of the vehicles were left unlocked.
- Officers continue to cite numerous individuals in the 2700 block of Brownsville for offenses such as disorderly conduct and public intoxication.
- Officers are aggressively patrolling the Brentwood Park area during the construction project and so far, no incidents of theft, vandalism, or criminal mischief have occurred.
