Other Police Business;

- One officer remains off-duty on a work related injury
- Three applications were submitted for the position of, Crossing Guard. A, Lisa Fehr, has been hired to fill one opening, one applicant was disqualified, and we are currently working on the third.
- Officer Christian Heynes completed a three day training class titled, Interview and Interrogation, conducted on January 8th, 9th, and 10th.
- Officer Matt DeLallo, with the assistance of school security director, Joe Kozarian, assisted St. Sylvesters' in developing a threat assessment plan that is being implemented within the school. The Brentwood Police Department also spoke to their faculty on a wide range of topics dealing with school security, major incident prevention, and reacting to an active threat.
- Officer Mike Fisher and the Brentwood Police Department received a letter of commendation from the Elizabeth Twp Police Dept. for apprehending a suspect in a child molesting incident that occurred in their jurisdiction.
