

Can't make rent because of COVID-19? Get help until you can.

Apply for Allegheny County Emergency Rental Assistance to pay rent and utilities if you've lost income or experienced financial hardship due to the pandemic.



Who can apply?

Money is available for rent and utilities to renting households that:

- have at least one person who qualifies for unemployment, has lost income, or suffered financially due to COVID-19
- are at risk of experiencing homelessness if they don't get help
- have a total income below 80% of the Area Median Income for Allegheny County

How can I apply?

- Complete your application and upload required documents all online.
- If you don't have WiFi or a computer or just need help filling out the application, contact ACTION-Housing at 412-248-0021.
