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### RESIDENTIAL TRASH SERVICE WAIVER

Under Chapter 174 of the Brentwood Borough Code, all owners of residential properties containing four or fewer individual units are **required** to utilize the trash and recycling service provided by the Borough. Trash fees will automatically be applied to each unit that contains an active sewage account and will be reflected on the monthly sewage statement issued by the Borough. However, courtesy waiver opportunities are available if a property becomes vacant for one of the following reasons:

- **Exemption A:** A property is permanently vacated due to the relocation or death of an owner-occupant. Such waiver shall be valid until the property is newly occupied.
- **Exemption B:** A property is temporarily vacated due to an owner-occupant residing at an alternative, semi-permanent address for a portion of the year. Such waiver shall be valid for a period of up to six (6) months.

**Rental properties that are temporarily vacant due to a chance in tenancy are not eligible for a service waiver.**
